

Code of conduct for students when working with life models

- **Students are expected to be kind and considerate towards the model at all times.**
- **Keep a respectful distance from the model and never touch them** (even if measuring).
 - When in pose please do not invade the model's personal space.
 - Some models may be ok with you taking close measurements but please assume this is not allowed unless you hear otherwise.
 - Karin will ask the model before the class what he/she is comfortable with and will inform all students before or during the session.
 - **If** the model is ok with close measurements being taken, then do politely let them know that you are approaching so as to not make them jump.
- **No photos should ever be taken of the model by students.**
 - Students should never ask the model whether it is ok to have their photo taken as they may feel like they are being put on the spot and pressurised into saying yes.
 - Occasionally a model may be ok with photos being taken, but they will inform Karin if this is the case. If you want to find out if this is the case then discreetly ask Karin at an appropriate time.
 - Sometimes students will not finish sculpting the pose while the model is here. In the eventuality of this...
 - ...Karin will take photos of the model if they are comfortable with that. These will be printed off for study by students at the studio. **The photos must remain at the studio and never leave the premises.**
- **Phones should be put on silent or at the very least a low ring volume during class.**
- **Phone calls should be taken outside of the studio at all times.**
