What will you be doing on the course?

Over the course of two days, you will learn all about the screen-printing process. You will get to try out and experiment with a range of techniques and styles and I will be on hand to guide and advise you every step of the way.

How to prepare?

On the Sunday I will go through the photographic screen-printing process with you step by step.

Transferring your pictures from a digital image to a screen ready for printing can be quite a lengthy process. For this reason, it would be great if you could send me a small collection of your chosen imagery (4 or 5 images) via [email](#). This will mean I can begin to prepare the screens, giving us more time for printing.

I will be exposing two of your images to screens, however by sending me 4 or 5 image options I will be able to choose the two most appropriate for this process. Also, when emailing your images please do let me know which are your preferred two images. **Please send me your images at least 1 week before the course date.**

On the studio's [acknowledgement page](#) is another explaining a little more about various screen-printing techniques, this should help you to decide which images to choose. It is also a good idea to have a quick google image search of screen print examples. You will also find examples on my [website](#) or [Instagram](#). 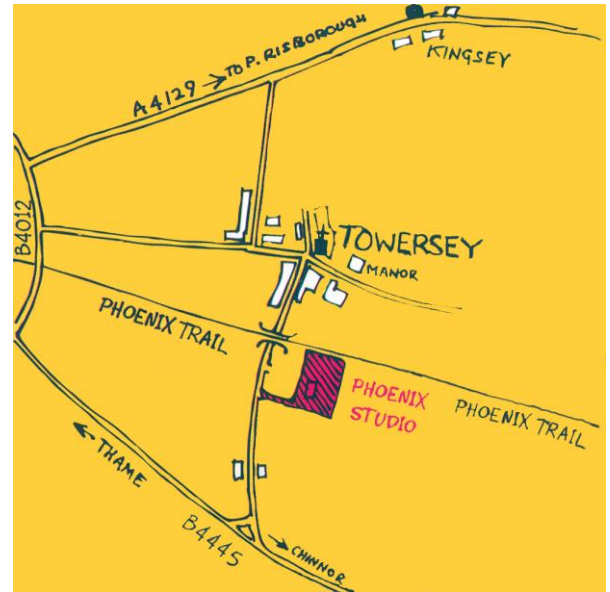
